We offer FREE LEGAL HELP

for low-income and vulnerable residents of Bucks, Chester, Delaware and Montgomery counties.

Who we can help:

- Low-income individuals who meet financial eligibility guidelines. (In most cases, the upper limit for eligibility is 125% of the federal poverty level.
- Low- and moderate-income older adults
- ANY victim of domestic violence, regardless of income

Who we can't help:*

- Undocumented immigrants (Except for domestic violence cases)
- Defendants in Protection from Abuse cases
- Criminal defendants
- Those involved in civil cases that don't meet our priority guidelines

**Legal Aid makes every effort to refer individuals in these categories to other sources of legal assistance, such as their local bar association or lawyer referral service.*

About our staff and volunteers:

Legal Aid staff are experienced, licensed attorneys and paralegals with expertise in the areas of civil law that our vulnerable clients most often encounter.

Our volunteers are legal professionals who "give back" to their communities by assisting with legal representation, intake and other activities—all at no charge to our clients.
