FREE LEGAL CLINIC WEDNESDAY, APRIL 24, 2024 4pm-6pm

This Virtual Name Change Clinic is open to all adult residents of Montgomery County, PA, including transgender, nonbinary, and gender non-conforming residents. Volunteer attorneys trained in the process will be available to assist you in preparing name change petitions.

Important: Please carefully read the instructions below, then scan the **QR code below** with your camera or any QR code scanning app on your mobile device to pre-register and complete your required intake form.

Services will be offered free of charge on a first-come, first-served basis, with priority given to those who pre-register and complete their intake questionnaire **by Wednesday, April 10, 2024.**

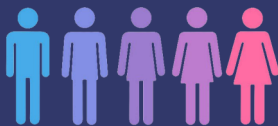
2. Confirmation Email w/ Appointment Time
